1. ANNOUNCEMENT:

The Alice Springs Motorcycle Club, hereafter called the PROMOTER will conduct the Narwietooma 3 Hour Desert Enduro for Junior and Senior classes at the track located on Narwietooma Station on **Sunday 14 March 2010**.

2. JURISDICTION:

- 2.1. The abovementioned meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling Australia Northern Territory which has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number **021/10** and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia National Licences.
- 2.2. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, and any final instructions approved by Motorcycling Australia Northern Territory.

BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.

3. ENTRIES:

- 3.1. Entries open forthwith and close at scrutineering on **Sunday 14 March 2010**
- 3.2. In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Alice Springs Motorcycle Club, if such retention is approved by Motorcycling Australia Northern Territory.
- 3.3. Only entries received on the official entry form that is accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.
- 3.4. **NOTE:- LATE ENTRIES MAY BE ACCEPTED AND THE RETURN OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE ALICE SPRINGS MOTORCYCLE CLUB.**

4. INSURANCE:

- 4.1. National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.
- 4.2. Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees.
- 4.3. **IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT WEEKLY BENEFITS INSURANCE.**

5. MEDICAL SERVICES:

Volunteers from St Johns Ambulance will be in attendance with an ambulance.

6. ENTRY FEE:

- 6.1. Seniors Entry Fee - \$30
Juniors Entry Fee - \$20.
- 6.2. Payment by cash, cheque or money order only. **ANY FEES FOR DISHONOURD CHEQUES WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRANT.**
- 6.3. Cheques and Money Orders are to be made payable to the Alice Springs Motorcycle Club.

7. ENTRY PASSES:

Not applicable

8. CLASSES OF COMPETITION:

The following classes will be run subject to rider numbers:

Pro Lite Class	125cc – 200cc 2 Stroke and 0 – 250cc 4 Stroke
Pro Open Class	250cc and above 2 Stroke, and 400cc and above 4 Stroke
Masters Class	35 years and over, all powers
Clubman Class	All powers
Pony Express	2 rider team, all powers
Junior 85cc	85cc 2 Stroke and 150cc 4 Stroke
Junior 125cc	Up to, 125cc 2 Stroke and 250cc 4 Stroke

9. AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY:

Rider/team points will be accumulated during the enduro series and totalled after final round of the series, each class will be awarded a 1st, 2nd and 3rd place trophy, provided adequate entries were received over the season to constitute a class.

10. ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:

To constitute a class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be 6 riders per class. Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards and / or prize money, will be at the discretion of the Alice Springs Motorcycle Club, subject to Motorcycling Australia Northern Territory approval.

11. MACHINES AND RIDERS:

- 11.1. All machines entered must comply with the current GCRs for Enduro competition.
- 11.2. Multiple entry of the one machine in the same class of competition is not permitted.
- 11.3. The rider on entering the event confirms their bike is in good working order and mechanically sound.
- 11.4. The rider must complete the race on the machine they started on. All repairs must be completed by the competitor and outside assistance will comply with the GCRs.

12. RIDING NUMBERS:

Rider grid numbers will be drawn by the riders at the completion of sign-on. Grid numbers will be provided and must be placed on the front number plate of the machine. Riders entered in the Pony Express must have grid numbers on each of their bikes.

13. GRID POSITIONS AND STARTS:

- 13.1 Junior 125/250 class riders will depart before the 85cc class riders.
- 13.2 Junior and Senior riders grid position will be determined by grid draw.
- 13.3 Once drawn, riders are not permitted to exchange grid positions and must immediately report the number drawn to the official scorer.
- 13.4 Number of riders per grid (1 or 2) and offset time (30 or 60 sec) will be determined on the day subject to entries and track conditions.

14. RIDERS' BRIEFING:

- 14.1 A junior riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing on Sunday. ALL junior competitors and parents/guardians MUST attend to be eligible to compete.
- 14.2 A senior riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing on Sunday. ALL senior competitors MUST attend this riders briefing to be eligible to compete in the race.

15. DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

- 15.1 All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any competition in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Drug Agency.
- 15.2 If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline, tel 1800 020 506. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prize money may be delayed at the discretion of Club or MANT until the results of the tests are known.
- 15.3 For the purposes of drug and alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be **8.00am on Sunday 14 March 2010** with the completion of the meeting for the participant being when the participant has vacated the venue.

16. CODE OF CONDUCT:

All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia by-law - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCRs), which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this meeting and will be enforced. Riders, pit crew and spectators are reminded that the Alice Springs Motorcycle Club events are for families including young children. Drunk and disorderly behaviour is dangerous, disrespectful, and will not be tolerated. Out of control people will be asked to leave, enforced by police if necessary. On Saturday night there will be an 11.00pm curfew at the track campsite to allow families, riders, and officials to get required sleep prior to the event.

18. CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:

- 18.1 The senior track is ~30 km and consists of station tracks, some rocky terrain, narrow tracks through trees, and undulating mulga and claypan country with several creek crossings and sand dunes. The track width is defined as 6 metres either side of the marked track. Riding outside of the defined track width could be deemed as cutting the course and subject to penalty at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.
- 18.2 The junior track is 11 km and consists of station tracks, some rocky terrain, narrow tracks through trees, undulating mulga country, and sand dunes. The track width is defined as 6 metres either side of the marked track. Riding outside of the defined track width could be deemed as cutting the course and subject to penalty at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.

19. RACING:

- 19.1 Riders will be given a sighting lap prior to the race commencing.
- 19.2 Riders on the start grid will be given a five second warning prior to their start time and will commence racing when a green flag is waved. Race times will be corrected according to each riders offset start time, compassionate time, and penalty time. Racing is considered complete as each rider crosses the finish line for the first time after 3 hours (1.5 hours for junior riders) has elapsed from their offset start time. Riders will not be allowed to initiate any new laps after 3 hours (1.5 hrs for junior riders) has elapsed from their offset start time. Any rider that fails to complete racing within 3 hrs 45 min (2 hrs 15 min for junior) from their offset start time or fails to report to an official upon completion will receive a DNF.
- 19.3 On approaching the start line riders will slow when entering the marked chute. On reaching the scoring table the riders will come to a complete stop. The rider's number plate will be marked prior to the rider leaving the start line.
- 19.4 Whilst riding through the pit area all bikes will be in first gear and ride at walking pace. A green flag will identify the location where the rider can commence riding at racing speed. Riders that roost in this area will be penalized at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.
- 19.5 Riders must take their bike across the finish line with full riding gear still worn.

20. NOISE:

Camping areas will be identified at Narwietooma race track. Competitors and associates are reminded to be considerate of other campers and limit noise as stipulated in the Code of Conduct section.

21. GST:

The Goods and Services Tax affects the payment of prize money. If you do not provide an ABN or declare the sport is a hobby, the Promoter must withhold 48.5% of prize money over \$50.00 which is otherwise payable to you. Please tick one of the boxes on the entry form and if appropriate provide your ABN to ensure the full amount of prize money is paid to you.

22. FUEL:

The Clerk of Course may direct random fuel testing in accordance with GCR 12.9.3 at anytime. All machines must comply with GCR 25.3.

23. SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:

- 23.1 Admission to the racetrack and spectator area is free.
- 23.2 Riders are to be aware the area surrounding the race track is private station property. All care should be taken to look after the area. Police may be in attendance with breathalysers and speed radars may be in operation.
- 23.3 Camping areas are provided at the race track start line and pits area. Camping fires allowed only in the cleared areas.
- 23.4 There are no toilets and showers available. Everyone is to supply their own camping gear, food and water.
- 23.5 WARNING – Strictly no fireworks allowed on Narwietooma Station due to extreme fire hazard.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS AND OBLIGATIONS

2. **I ACKNOWLEDGE** that the sport of motorcycle racing is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport and participating in the race meeting I take and am exposed to certain risks and dangers and am under certain obligations as follows:

- a) that I may be injured, physically or mentally, and may be killed;
- b) that my machinery or equipment may be damaged, lost or destroyed;
- c) that other competitors may ride dangerously or with lack of skill;
- d) that track or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability;
- e) that the organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agent or representatives of those in charge of race meetings are frequently obliged to make decisions under pressure of time and/or events;
- f) that any policy of insurance of or in respect of my life or physical or mental health may be avoided;
- g) that there may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport of me if I am injured;
- h) that by entering the event my machine is in good working order;
- i) that I have an obligation to myself and others to compete safely and within the rules of competition.

INDEMNITY GIVEN TO ORGANISERS

3. **IN CONSIDERATION** of the acceptance of me as an entrant in the meeting **I AGREE TO INDEMNIFY** the organisers and each of them in the following manner:

- a) that I participate in the race meeting at my sole risk and responsibly;
- b) that I accept the venue as it stands with all or any defect hidden or exposed;
